

The ACP Internal Medicine In-Training Examination® is a web-based self-assessment exam designed for residency programs to assess the progress of their residents during training and in preparation for the initial certification exam.

The IM-ITE® is developed by a committee of expert physicians and is used by residency programs to assess residents' knowledge and skills, during training and in preparation for their initial certification exam. It is modeled after the American Board of Internal Medicine's certification exam. The exam is administered annually during a strictly monitored window.

Give residents an opportunity for self-assessment.

Give program directors the opportunity to evaluate their programs.

Identify areas in which residents need extra assistance.

Programs will have the option for in-person testing or remote proctoring and testing or a combination of both, using third-party software (Zoom, MS Teams, or Webex).

The goal of the IM-ITE® is to gauge progress in training. For the most accurate assessment, residents
